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UNIFORM IDENTIFICATION

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING

Classroom PBL lessons in the first two weeks of school will be focusing on ALL settings and how students can be respectful, safe and responsible in each setting, at all times.

SCHOOL REWARDS

Caught you being good tokens are rewarded on a daily basis by teachers and staff to student for exhibiting the three core values. These are collected in classroom boxes and tallied each week. At Friday assemblies, the collective tokens are put in a barrel and 3 winners are drawn to collect a prize or change the school song for the week.

Kangaroo stamps are awarded to the infants and primary students who each have a chart in class. When 5 stamps have been awarded, the student receives a red merit award. When 80 stamps have been awarded, the student receives a school wrist band with a core value printed on it. Students are aiming to get all three wrist bands.



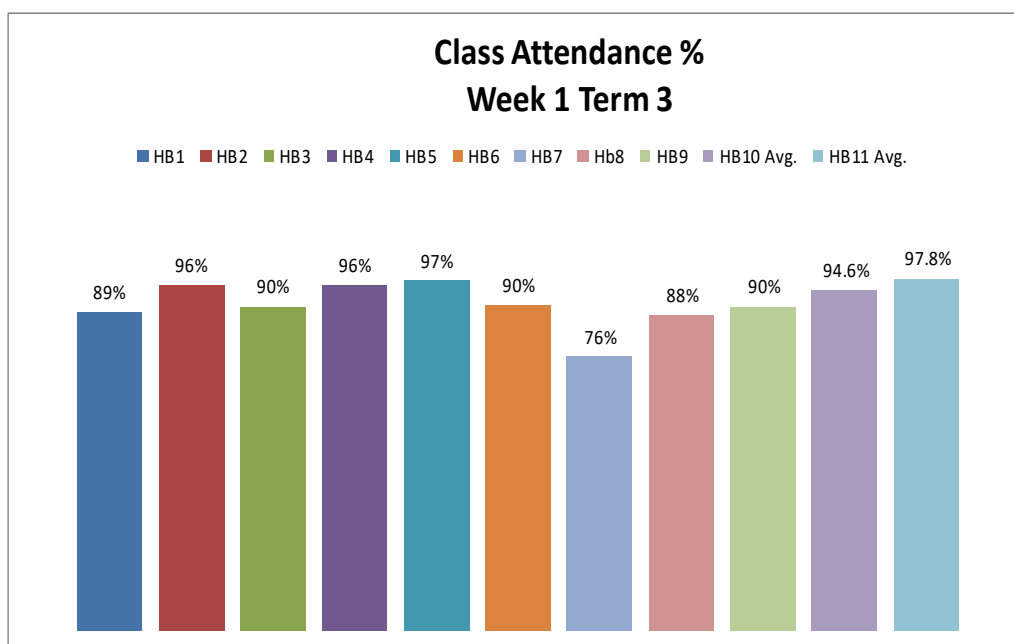
ATTENDANCE

EXPLAINING ABSENCES

If your child is absent from school, parents are required to provide an explanation for the absences within 7 days.

When a student returns to school after an absence, they must bring a note from their parent/carer, explaining the absence and provide it to their class teacher.

Alternatively, parents can explain an absence via the **Skool Loop app** under the 'Absentee' icon. This can be done on the day of the absence or upon returning to school.
