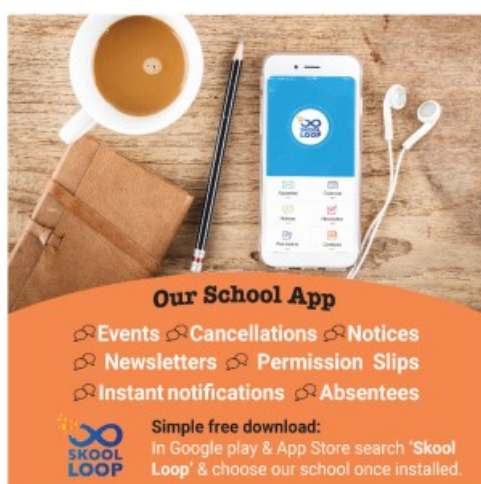

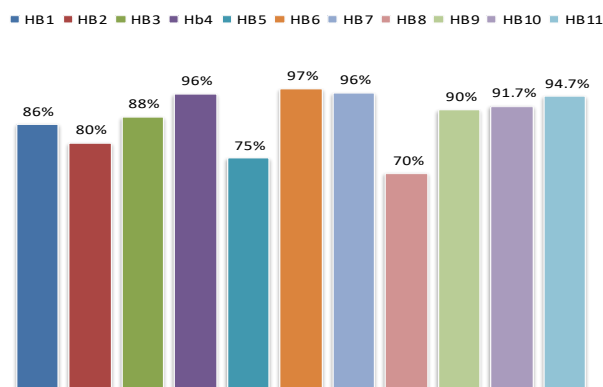
EXPLANATION OF ABSENCES
