## FATHER'S DAY STALL

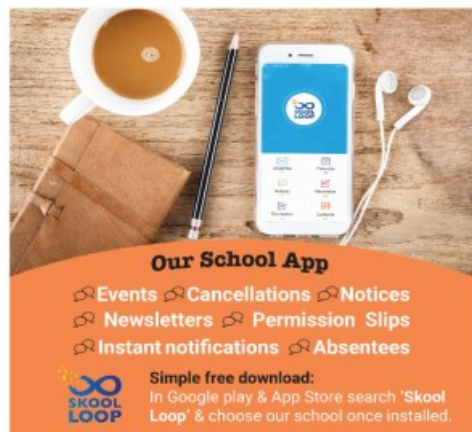

# HB10 PRESCHOOL NEWS

## SWAY in action!

In SWAY HB 10 have been learning about 'My Culture My History'. Areas of learning have included: Dream stories / Learning some native animals names in Wadi Wadi/ Prepositional concepts/ Identifying the first sounds of words and blending sounds to make CVC words and name writing. Our current project is based on the Australian Biomes and the African Biomes incorporating native animals. The children have devised a KWL chart and created a beautiful 3D picture of the Australian Bush using natural materials from our playground.

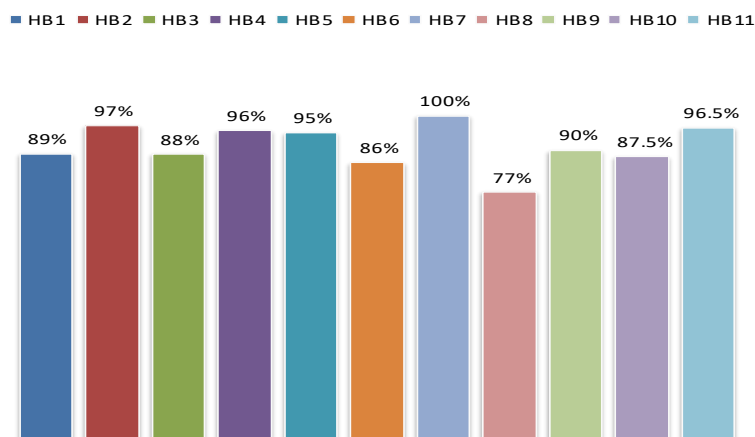
## EXPLANATION OF ABSENCES

When a student returns to school after an absence, they must bring a note from their parent/carer, explaining the absence and provide it to their class teacher.
