CLASS DOJO - From Preschool to Year 6, our school is using Class Dojos this year as a communication tool between classrooms and families. Teachers have issued invitations to parents so they can join our school community. Teachers will be using the Dojo app as



a student reward system, to encourage a positive growth mindset, and communicate more frequently to parents. If you haven't received your invitation please ask your child's class teacher for another to be printed for you.

DIGITAL PORTFOLIOS—This year we will also be using the Dojo system in place of our Portfolios that are given in Terms 1 and 3. We will be using the student's individual profile to upload a digital portfolio throughout the year. With this, parents will only see their own child's individual portfolio which allows for positive feedback from their teachers and their parents.

StEPS EYE SCREENING

On Thursday 5 March, Statewide Eyesight Preschooler Screening (StEPS) a NSW Health initiative will be conducting a free vision screening for students in Kindergarten that have not previously been assessed. Notes will be sent home today with all Kindergarten students. Vision screening for our Preschool students will be scheduled for later in the year.

At our school, we use <u>Positive Behaviour for Learning</u> – a whole-school approach for creating a positive, safe and supportive school climate where students can learn and develop. Our whole school community works together to establish expected behaviours and teach them to all students. Parents and students will be noticing signage that will be displayed in various outside areas reflecting expectations of students under the three school values, **Respect, Safe** and **Responsible**.

Students are given 'Caught you being good tokens' with our school crest reflecting our three core values. As students are awarded the tokens for exhibiting positive behaviours, they are informed of the school value which most complies with this behaviour. We have had a very successful start to implementing the school's PBL model this year and will continue to discuss the three values during our classroom PBL lessons as we analyse each area of the school and we discuss behaviours and expectations.


ATTENDANCE

EXPLANATION OF ABSENCES

If your child is absent from school, parents are required to provide an explanation for the absences within 7 days.

When a student returns to school after an absence, they must bring a note from their parent/carer, explaining the absence and provide it to their class teacher.

Alternatively, **parents can explain an absence via the Skool Loop app under the 'Absentee' icon.** This can be done on the day of the absence or upon returning to school.



ATTENDANCE POLICY

Regular attendance at school for every student is essential if students are to achieve their potential, and increase their career and life options. The department has very strict guidelines around recording absences and what is accepted as justified or unjustified leave. The guidelines state: Students are recorded as absent if no explanation has been provided by parents within seven days of the occurrence of an absence or the explanation is not accepted by the principal. It is at the principal's discretion to accept or not accept the explanation provided. Principals can decline to accept an explanation for an absence and record the absence as 'unjustified'. The school may request a medical certificate in addition to explanations.

We understand that at times and during stressful or unforeseen circumstances, it is difficult to have your child attend school for a day or part of a day. For this reason and where possible, it is good practice to request documentation from a specialist or doctor or medical appointment where a child is sick or unable to attend school due to an unrelated illness of their own. The documentation does not need to state what the illness is or disclose any personal information. The documentation would only be used to justify the absence on the appropriate date and would only need to state attendance of the appointment on the absent date.

As we are a departmental organisation we are governed by policies and procedures that are mandatory for the school to follow. However, we are here to support all families with the requirements set out by the department. If you have any concerns or require any further information or need support around your child's school attendance please do not hesitate to contact the school for assistance.
