Books in Home

We're excited to share a wonderful program with you called 'Books in Homes®'. This program is all about providing children with books of their choice. It's a fantastic way to get kids engaged with reading and helps them develop the reading skills they need for success in the long run.

Our school strongly supports this program, thanks to the hard work of Mrs. Breasley, who has been tirelessly organising it. The best part is, at the end of each year, the children get to receive their books as donations!

Professional Learning at KPS

At our school, we really focus on the Science of Reading and Learning. We want to share this reading culture with our community, so we encourage and support our students to read every day. We also encourage families to read to their children and have a great selection of books for everyone to choose from.



Over the past two years, our staff has been diving into some fascinating topics like cognitive load theory, working memory, and schema theory. We'd love to share what we're learning with you every couple of weeks and take you on this journey of lifelong learning with us.

<u>Cognitive Load Theory</u> - What Is It? Cognitive load theory starts with the idea that we can only take in so much information before it all becomes too much to handle. Think of it like a sponge that can only soak up a limited amount of water. If we overload our brains with too much information, it becomes tough to learn.

Cognitive load theory tells us that people, whether they're kids or adults, learn best under the right conditions, using learning tasks that suit their style and the application of the information. It's all about finding the right balance. We've discovered that there are three types of cognitive load:

<u>Intrinsic</u>: This is the hard stuff, like complex tasks with many steps that can be challenging to learn and remember.

<u>Extraneous:</u> This is the tricky one. It's when you're trying to focus, but there are distractions like loud noises or interruptions.

Germane: This is the sweet spot, the ideal learning condition we aim for.

Principal Message:

Here's how you can help us help your child with their learning:

- Make sure your child is at school on time. Our Morning Routine program runs from 9 am to 9:30 am every day and is important for every student. This is the lesson that will set up your child's learning day.
- Read a variety of texts to your child. The more knowledge they have, the better they'll be at reading and writing.
- When working with your child at home, break down information into simple, logical steps and practice with them.
- Share what you're doing at home with your child's teacher. We love to hear about the books you're reading and the experiences you're having.
