Variety has created we care therapy grant, which is allowing them to provide financial assistance to children who need it the most. There are grants of up to \$2000 over a 12 month period for therapy that include: physiotherapy, OT, speech therapy, hydrotherapy, psychology and exercise physiology. It's for 0-18 years old living in NSW/ACT with household income of less than \$120,000 pa where they are waiting for NDIS or are not eligible.



Every year, hundreds of children who have been have been diagnosed with a disability or long-term health condition have to face long wait times for an NDIS plan or are ineligible for NDIS support altogether. That's why Variety NSW/ACT has created the We Care Therapy grant, providing financial assistance towards therapy costs to assist children who need it most.

Grants of up to \$2000 are available over a twelve-month period and applications are open all year round.

Eligible therapy requests include:

Physiotherapy
Occupational Therapy
Speech Therapy
Hydrotherapy
Psychology
Exercise Physiology

Your child doesn't need a diagnosis to get help

If you have a child younger than 7, and are concerned about their development, talking to a professional who knows your child best, is a good place to start.

This could be your child's doctor, early childhood educator or child health nurse.

Concerns about your child's development may include how they:

Play and move around
Do things to take care of themselves
Socialise with other children
Communicate what they want
Compared with other children their age.

If your child's health or education professional agrees there are developmental concerns, our early childhood partners can help connect you to the right supports. You do not need a diagnosis from a medical professional to access support through our early childhood approach.

Connect with your local early childhood partner

Our early childhood partners are professionals with experience working with children with developmental delay or disability and their families.

Early childhood partners will work with you to understand your child's needs and connect you to the supports and services that best meet your child's needs. These supports and services are called early connections.



- South East Sydney
- Sydney.

Your early childhood partner can:

- connect you to local services such as child health services, playgroups, childcare, parent support groups, education options and recreation and give you practical information about child development
- use observations and information from screening tools, assessments or reports to understand the impact of your child's delay or disability
- where appropriate provide a short period of early supports to help you and your child to work towards goals
- support you to apply to the NDIS if you decide to apply on your child's behalf, including support to put together information and evidence to help to work out goals
- help you connect with best practice early childhood intervention services
- monitor your child's progress and support them to transition from the early childhood approach.
